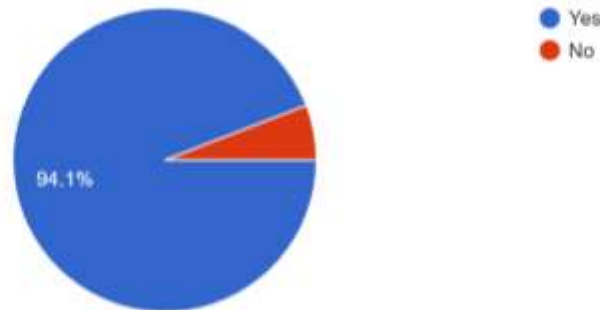
An impressive 96.7% of alumni found the course curriculum intellectually stimulating, indicating that the curriculum effectively engaged students in meaningful learning experiences.

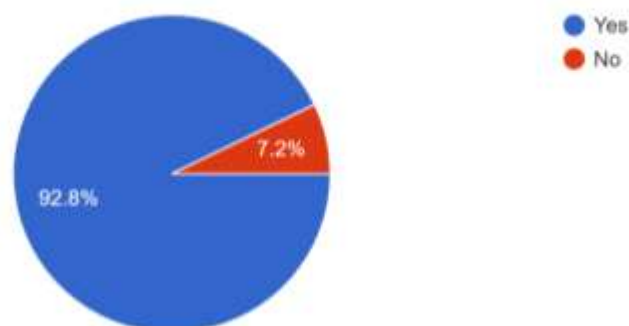

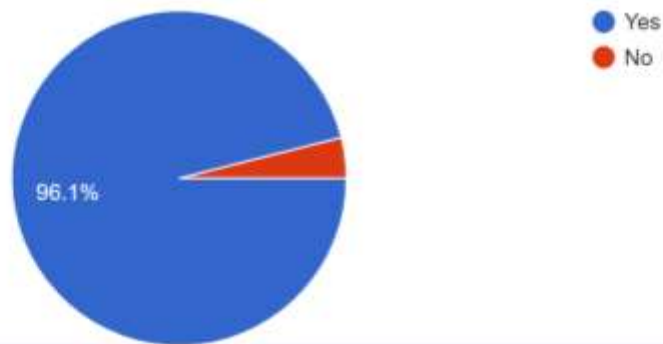
92.8% of alumni indicated that they learned new skills during their studies, reflecting the effectiveness of the curriculum in providing practical knowledge and competencies.

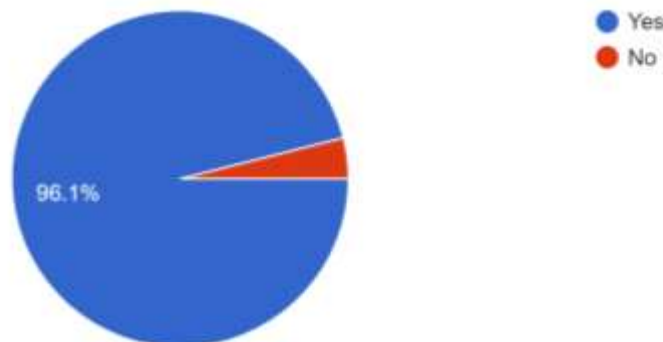


The syllabus inspired interest in research for 96.1% of alumni, highlighting the curriculum's role in fostering academic curiosity and exploration.

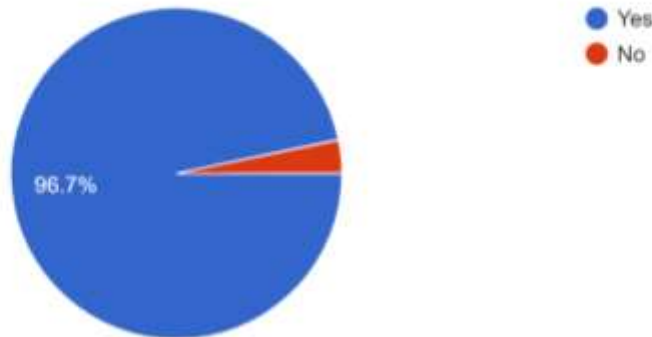
- 96.1% of alumni agreed that the subjects/courses helped in developing their personalities, suggesting that the curriculum supports overall personal growth.

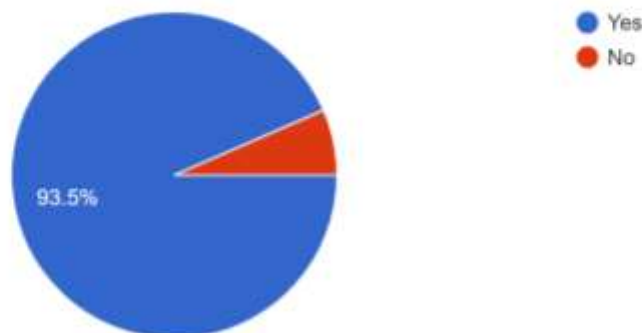

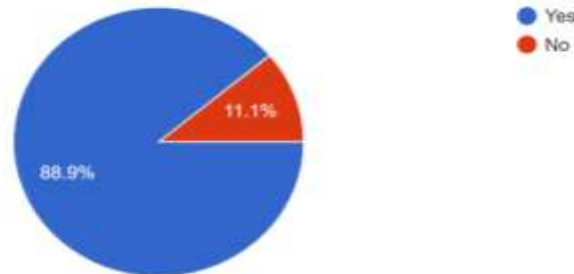
93.5% of alumni appreciated the developments at K.T.H.M. College in recent years, demonstrating the college's commitment to continuous improvement.

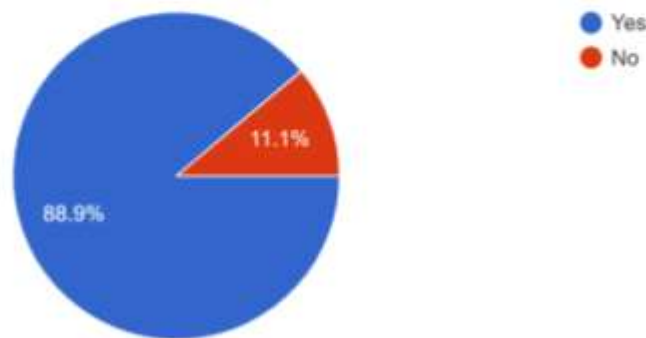


88.9% of alumni felt that K.T.H.M. College involved them in its activities, indicating a robust alumni network and engagement strategy.
